This month in club we will be exploring the techniques for embroidering stand alone lace edgings and borders. These laces must be joined in sections, and will be easy and fun to do as we create beautiful linens and towels.

Supply List: cont....

Embroidery machine; cleaned, oiled & ready to sew.

Embroidery presser foot & power cord

Organ Titanium Embroidery Needles size 75/11 or 80/12

*½ yd. White or beige polyester organza or silk organdy for lace collar designs.

Thread choices:

40 wt. Embroidery threads such as Isacord or Floriani

60 or 70 wt. cotton or silk for Zundt laces***

50 wt. Or 60 wt. Cotton for finer, lighter weight trims and collars.

***this weight of thread will need to be pre-ordered, as we do not keep it in stock.

Stabilizers:

One to three layers of water soluble mesh (Aqua Mesh or Aqua Magic)
(Do not use the wss that looks like plastic, as it is not enough support for these laces as they stitch.)
