

Quilting for Beginners

Supply List

The Log Cabin quilt design dates back to pioneer days. It is the perfect project for a beginning quilter. In this class you will learn how to choose colors, learn about all the different tools used in quilt making, how to use a rotary cutter, basic piecing techniques, simple quilting and last but not least how to put on binding.

You do not need all of these supplies for the Intro class. Just bring the *Make A Quilt in a Day Log Cabin Pattern* book by Eleanor Burns, and a pencil and paper to take notes.

Supplies:

- Sewing machine (You may bring your own or use one of ours)
 - Cleaned, oiled, and ready to sew
- Presser Feet
 - 1/4" foot with or without guide
 - Magnetic Seam Guide if your foot has no guide
- Needles
 - Schmetz 80/12 Universal Needles for piecing
 - Schmetz 75/11 Quilting Needles for finishing
- Thread
 - Large spool Mettler Polyester thread in a neutral or matching color (gray works well as a neutral color)
- Notions
 - *Make A Quilt in a Day Log Cabin Pattern* book by Eleanor Burns
 - Rotary Cutter
 - 18" x 24" Cutting mat
 - 6" x 24" ruler
 - Quilting pins
 - 1" Curved safety pins
 - Clover Seam Ripper
 - Optional:
 - Kwik Klip
 - June Tailor 12" x 18" Cut & Press
 - Hobbico Crest Iron
